Gender disparity manifests itself in various forms dur to social stereotyping the most attributed being the social and economic structure of a society.

Owing to the alleged discrimination and increasing gender inequality, after independence, Government took various measures to improve the status of women at both national and state levels. Article 14, 15(3), 16, 39, 42 and 51 (A) (e) contain various types of provision for equal rights and opportunities for women and eliminate discrimination against women in different spheres of life. Nevertheless, discrimination in various forms against the women are frequently alleged across in India. So it is need of the hour to comprehend those discrimination arising out of culture or outside culture and need of public intervention so as not only to arrest the gender discrimination in tribal areas but to create an equal and just society through public intervention especially the young educated mass.
