

CODE OF ETHICS FOR ALUMNI

- i) The Alumni of the University are required to participate in the development of and to promote the welfare of their alma mater as a leading University of the country.
- ii) recognize and identify the role of Alumni as important stakeholders in the continuing quest to provide excellence in education by way of academic and technical collaborations.
- iii) To provide academic and professional interaction and networking and act as a facilitator in matters of career opportunities, placement, coaching, expert lectures etc
- iv) To organize institute scholarships and promote exchange programmes of faculty and students of MSCBU with important national and international institutions/universities/ organizations.
- v) To enrich the physical and socio-cultural environment of the campuses of the University.
- vi) To create Endowment/Corpus fund for research/academic, faculty and student development and other purposes.
- vii) To organize socio-cultural events and interactions between Alumni and the stake holders of the University.
- viii) To provide opportunities for community service/charitable work and to act as goodwill ambassadors of the University.
- ix) To promote afforestation and other eco-friendly activities for the benefit of the University.
- x) And to secure any other objective(s) that the General Body may prescribe from time to time with a view to ensuring a meaningful role to be placed by the Alumni.
- xi) Alumni are requested to register for the membership of University Alumni Association.
- xii) Once a member, he/she may exercise his/her right to franchise in all the meetings of the Association and in the election of the office-bearers of the Association or any representative to any other body or in any other election that may be held.
- xiii) A member of the Association may move a proposal or bring forward a new business to the Annual General Body Meeting of the Association, provided that, previous notice of at least 14 days has been given in writing to the President.
- xiv) In addition to the above, the Alumni members are to abide by the Bylaws laid in for the formation and functioning of the Alumni Association of the University.
- xv) Last, but not the least, the Alumni member should always behave and conduct himself/herself with utmost dignity and integrity at their place of work and strive to keep the name of the Department / University high always.
